SELECT BOARD MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 28, 2021

MEMBERS PRESENT: Philip E. Mazzucco, Charles Rockwell, Thomas Wilson, Linda Montague and Deborah Baker.

OTHERS PRESENT: Andrea Lenhardt, Mark Gregory, Brett Lourie, Arlene Bentley, William Meyer, John LaVecchia and Kelli Raymond.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

1. About \$59,000 still out in taxes, though many people have been paying the full amount.

COMMUNICATIONS:

Charlie mentioned that there was a request from a retired Rutland attorney that the Town adopt a non-discrimination resolution for the Town.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Mark Gregory gave a presentation and also a demonstration of speed signs. He recommended a twelve inch display, and that a solar powered one would be the best. The signs cost \$2,800.00 each and can be moved to different locations. Unlimited training is provided at no extra cost. The company is out of Lake George and they make all their machines locally.
2. John LaVecchia is still checking into the easement area at the Town Green.
3. Bill Meyer gave a short update on the Communications Union District. There has been a change of some CUD officers, and the group is working on getting grant money.
4. Motion by Charlie, seconded by Debbie to have Michael Batchner send the new Hazard Mitigation Plan to the surrounding towns. Motion carried.
5. Charlie received two telephone calls in reference to the septic arrangement at the Aldonando residence.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. It was the consensus of the Board to set the zoning violation fees at \$100.00 per day until compliance is met.
2. The Hazard Mitigation Plan was approved by consensus of the Board.
3. Kelli Raymond has had several complaints about unlicensed dogs, and one dog bite. Also, the family on Route 30 is still living in filthy conditions and has a rat issue.
4. The Select Board has to approve a \$46,000.00 grant for the Rupert Village Trust, which will be a written resolution.
5. Tom signed electronically a document which will enable the Fire Company to obtain a grant to purchase new equipment.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. Bill wondered about all the unregistered cars at Timothy Saunders.
2. Perhaps Brett will get trained to set up the speed signs and move them around Town.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:
